RANDOLPH COUNTY DUST CONTROL POLICY

April 29th, 2025

Residents desiring dust control on gravel roads are responsible for the costs of materials and application of environmentally friendly agents. They shall contact the Randolph County Road and Bridge Department one week in advance of agent application to allow the county operators to recondition the road before application.

Once the dust control agent is applied, a sign must be purchased and installed by the landowner at the beginning and the end of the application, and county operators will not maintain the treated sections of road in order to allow the agent to accomplish its purpose. If the county operator does grade the treated area, Randolph County Road and Bridge assumes no responsibility for unintended action. Regular road maintenance would resume when road conditions indicate normal maintenance is necessary.
